NOMINATION PACKAGES AVAILABLE

Nomination packages for potential candidates in the 2018 Local Government Election **are now available at City Hall**. The package contains information for candidates and a number of forms to be completed. A person must be nominated by two eligible electors.

A person is qualified for office if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general election day;
- Resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- Not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or is not otherwise disqualified by law.

Packages can be picked up at Corporate Services on the second floor of City Hall between 8:30 a.m. and 12 p.m. and 1 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

The nomination period begins at 9 a.m. September 4, 2018 and ends at 4 p.m. September 14, 2018. One Mayor and six Councillors are to be elected for a four-year term beginning November 6, 2018. **General Voting Day is October 20** at the Marie Sharpe Elementary School gym from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Advance voting days are October 10 and October 17 in the City Hall foyer, also from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.
