



# 2018 ELECTION

## VOTING BY MAIL

The City of Williams Lake will be offering mail ballot voting for the **2018 General Local Election**, as provided under Section 110 of the *Local Government Act*. This will provide an opportunity for more electors to participate in the local government election, including snowbirds and others who will be absent from the community during the voting period.

Electors can vote by mail if they:

- Have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity, or
- Expect to be absent from the City on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities (October 10 and 17).

Those electors wishing to vote by mail are requested to submit a completed [Application to Vote by Mail](#) to the Chief Election Officer as soon as possible. If you are not on the Voters List, Elector registration may be done in conjunction with mail voting.

[Applications](#) will be accepted by mail or fax. Ballot packages will be mailed approximately October 5th. For any applications received after that date, ballot packages will be available for pickup only at the Election Office. Delivery arrangements for ballot packages are the responsibility of the elector and completed ballots must be received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8:00 pm on General Voting Day, Saturday, October 20, 2018.
